**SELMA MAN SENTENCED TO 20 YEARS IN PRISON FOR CHILD
MOLESTATION**

Today in Department 3 of the Tulare County Superior Court, Visalia Division, Judge James Hollman sentenced Demetrio Yebra, age 37, of Selma, to 20 years in prison for child molestation.

On April 7, 2017, Yebra pleaded no contest to 20 counts of lewd act upon a child under the age of 14.

The crimes occurred in Tulare and Fresno counties between July 2015 and March 2016 against a single minor victim. In addition to his sentence, Yebra must register as a sex offender for the remainder of his life.

The case was prosecuted by Deputy District Attorney Laura Jackson of the Crimes against Children Division and investigated by the Tulare County Sheriff's Office and Fresno County Sheriff's Office.
