DUCOR WOMAN ARRESTED IN PHOENIX FOR IDENTITY THEFT AND CHECK FRAUD

On August 3, 2017, Criminal Investigators from the District Attorney's Bureau of Investigations arrested Nancy Fleetwood, age 37, of Ducor, for allegations of check counterfeiting and identity theft.

After conducting an extensive investigation, which included serving multiple search warrants, interviewing numerous witnesses, as well as obtaining video evidence, Fleetwood was charged with felony counts involving counterfeit checks that originated from Tulare County Health and Human Services and Tulare County Child Support Services. Fleetwood was also wanted on over \$100,000 of outstanding arrest warrants for various drug-related offenses.

Investigators located Fleetwood in Phoenix, Arizona, where she was arrested and extradited back to Tulare County. She was arraigned on August 18, 2017, on four counts of burglary, four counts of forgery, and one count of identity theft. A preliminary hearing is set for August 29, 2017, in Department 4 of the Tulare County Superior Court.
